

“How Do I Get Involved?”

Good question! In ConvergeNW Church Planting we’re not as interested in “recruiting” church planters and team members as we are in “spotting” them. The following 10-step Involvement Funnel helps explain the process whereby we help potential candidates determine God’s call on their lives.

1. You may have already done this and have written information on our movement. You may attend one of our district events such as the New Church Incubator to get a better idea of what we’re about.

Initial Contact

2. Next, we’ll talk at length—either over the telephone or face to face—to discuss you options and possibilities in church planting.

Personal Interview

Pre-assessment

3. If you’re interested in continuing, fill out the enclosed application form and return it to us. From this we will compile a preliminary report to determine if it’s worth proceeding.

Formal Assessment

4. At this point we will formally assess you and your spouse, either through a 4-day Assessment Center or one day Behavioral Interview.

Expectations Interview

5. If you pass the formal assessment we will go over expectations which you will have of ConvergeNW ChurchPlanting and that we will have of you. This is done to make sure that we understand policies and procedures so we can move ahead harmoniously.

Project Proposal

6. We will ask you to work through a six page church planting proposal which will outline the details of your anticipated project.

Formal Call

7. The ConvergeNW Church Planting Committee will issue a formal call to you to join our church planting team, including salary and workfund arrangements.

Training

8. Should you accept the call, we will send you to a national training event such as “First Steps” or its equivalent.

Transition

9. You and your teammates will raise support, mobilize your intercessors, and move to your mutually agreed-upon church planting site.

Church Planting

10. You will be coached by experienced personnel throughout all stages of your church plant. You and your spouse will be supported through the New Church Incubator system, district retreats, and special events.
